III. Competition Rules

1. For the 5 km, 10 km and 15 km distances, the use of wetsuits, commercial swim fins (**no apparatus fins**) and goggles is permitted.
2. For the 1 km and the 2,5 km course the use of wetsuits and goggles is allowed.
3. The ranking is based on the overall result and separated by gender and distance. In the results lists, an entry is made as to whether the swimmer swam with or without fins. There is no separate scoring with or without the use of fins.
4. The distance specified in the registration must be kept, an early exit or an extension of the distance will not be scored.
5. The swim course, which is marked by buoys and indicated on the general map, must be followed. The swim course can be found at www.lss-ruppin.de.
6. Failure to comply with the swim distance will result in disqualification or time penalty.
7. The instructions of the event staff and the referees must be followed.
8. In case of exhaustion or signs of cramps, the participant must make himself known to the boat staff by waving the bathing cap.
9. If a participant is taken on board, he will be eliminated from the current competition.
10. Own food is allowed. Bananas and tea will also be served at 5 km, 10 km and 15 km during the competition.
11. The issued bathing caps are **COMPULSORY CLOTHING**.
12. Wearing the transponder for timekeeping is mandatory, manipulations or starting without transponder will lead to disqualification.
13. In the interest of the swimmers' health, we have decided to set a time limit. The competition will end at 16:00. All swimmers still in the water will then be taken out of the water.
14. In case of loss of a transponder, a fee of 25,- Euro will be charged.
